- Recovery house opened in the fall of 2019, serving women and their children, expanding the recovery continuum of care.
- Planning and remodeling of our new satellite office in Geneva, Ohio.
- Quickly and efficiently transitioned clinical services to remote care in response to the onset of the pandemic.



ORGANIZATIONAL STABILITY & GROWTH

- Established Chief Clinical Officer position and Executive Team structure in 2019.
- Established Team Lead positions in late 2019 and filled all positions in 2020.
- Promoted programmatic growth through collaboration with Ashtabula Area City Schools and the Ashtabula County YMCA.



ORGANIZATIONAL CULTURE

- The agency purchased and implemented an electronic supervision tracking system (Performance Pro) to enhance supervision, the appraisal process, and communication.
- Working to increase objectivity in the appraisal process through development of quality measures.

- The agency has a long history of involvement in community coalitions and supporting fellow non-profit organizations.
